AGD Donates RM100,000 To SK Rawang Under MADANI Adopted School Programme

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 11 (Bernama) -- The Accountant General's Department (AGD) has allocated RM100,000 to upgrade facilities and infrastructure at Sekolah Kebangsaan (SK) Rawang, Selangor, through the MADANI 2025 Adopted School programme.

It said in a statement that the project, implemented to address the education gap by matching capable organisations with schools in need, is expected to be fully completed by September.
